Minutes of the June 16, 2014 regular meeting and the June 24, 2014 special meeting were approved as written on motion of Hinde and second of Lotts. Vote all aye.

The agenda was approved as amended on motion of Lizer and second of Hinde. Vote all aye.

Linda Ohrt of State Bank and Tiffany Asche from Peoples Savings Bank reviewed their proposals for banking services to the district. Koop thanked Ohrt and Asche for their time and they left the meeting.

The review of Board Policy Series 700 - 900 was tabled until the full board is present.

On motion of Lotts and second of Koop, the 2013-14 Annual Salaries Statement was approved and authorized for publications. Vote all aye.

The Board reviewed the 2015 Legislative Action Priorities. On motion of Lizer and second of Hinde, items 6, 12, 14, 22 and 35 were selected to present to IASB for their review at the August Legislative Resolutions Committee. Vote all aye.

Infinite Campus contracts were tabled until the August meeting in order to obtain cost information.

An out of state volleyball trip for the Fall of 2014 was changed from Chicago to Lenexa, Kansas on motion of Lotts and second of Lizer. Vote all aye.

The proposed athletic trainer contract with UNI was denied on motion of Lotts and second of Hinde. All aye.

The increased 2014-15 teaching contract of Laura Eiklenborg from 5 to 72 was approved on motion of Hinde and second of Lotts. Vote all aye. The meeting was called to order at 6:31 pm by Chairman Melcher.

The minutes of the May meeting were read and approved on a motion by Knaack, seconded by Riekena.

On a motion by Buhrow, seconded by Knaack, bills were approved totaling \$5446.18 for the Landfill Closure Fund and \$3415.93 for the citizen's Convenience Center.

Business Items:

The County Auditor's office received no bids for hauling refuse to the Rural Iowa Landfill by the published deadline (9 AM on 6/9/14) based upon the "Notice to Bidders" published in the Grundy Register. The Commission will continue to work with the existing long-time hauler.

Schoolman reported that Phelps implemented a tractor oil leak and short in the wiring. Things are going well at the Citizens Convenience Center. He has hauled 12,000 gallons of leachate since weather conditions have permitted hauling. The truck is functioning satisfactorily. The inventory list for the Landfill/CCC has been updated to include the new forklift.

On a motion by Smith, seconded by Buhrow, the Commission voted to approve the Financial Assurance document prepared by HLW Engineering. That report indicates that the balance in the closure fund on the date of the report was \$939,181, which exceeds the required amount of \$695,500.

Chm. Melcher indicated the he may be absent for the July meeting due work commitments. Ross will serve as Chm. in his absence. The July meeting will be held at the Landfill/CCC as has been past practice.

The meeting was adjourned on a motion by Smith and a second by Riekena at 6:53 pm.
